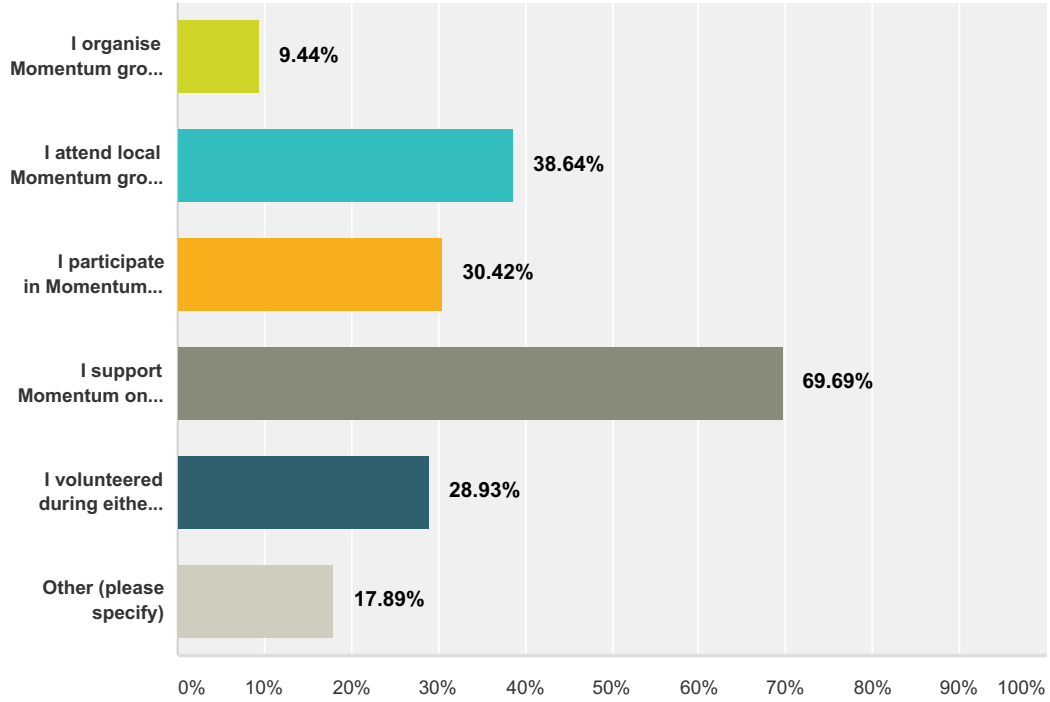
Number of Momentum members that were sent the survey: **20,076**

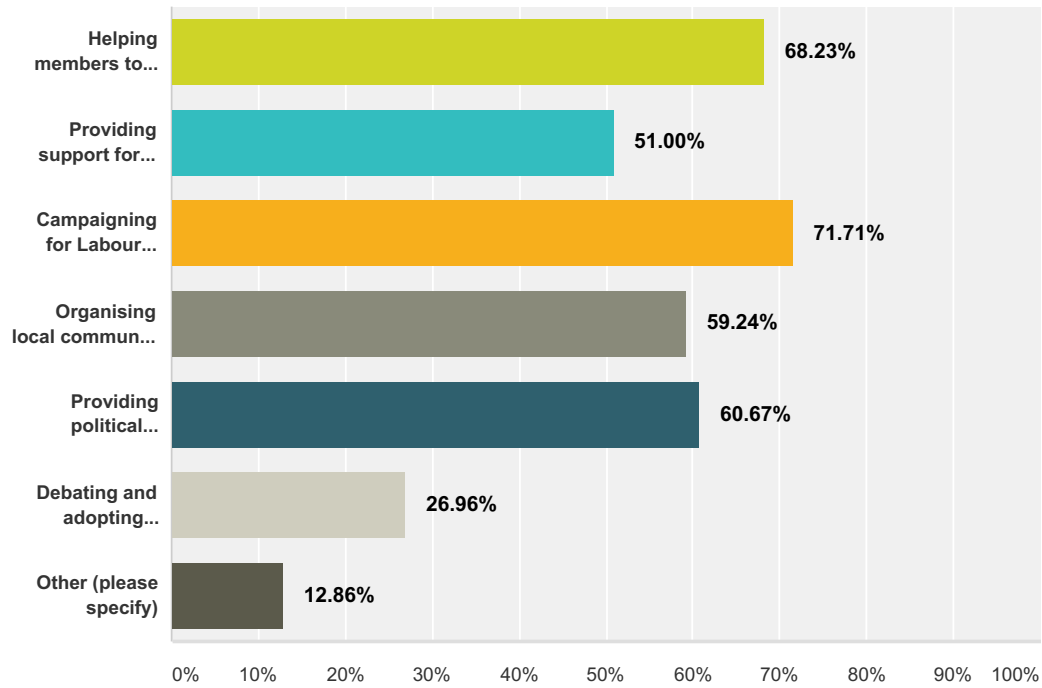

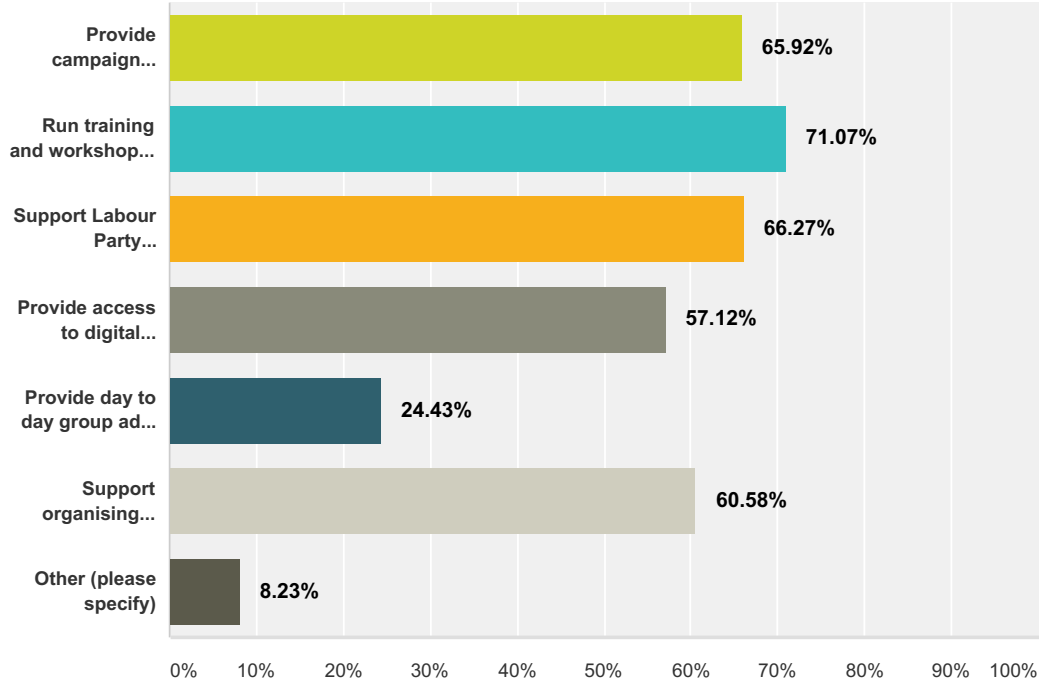

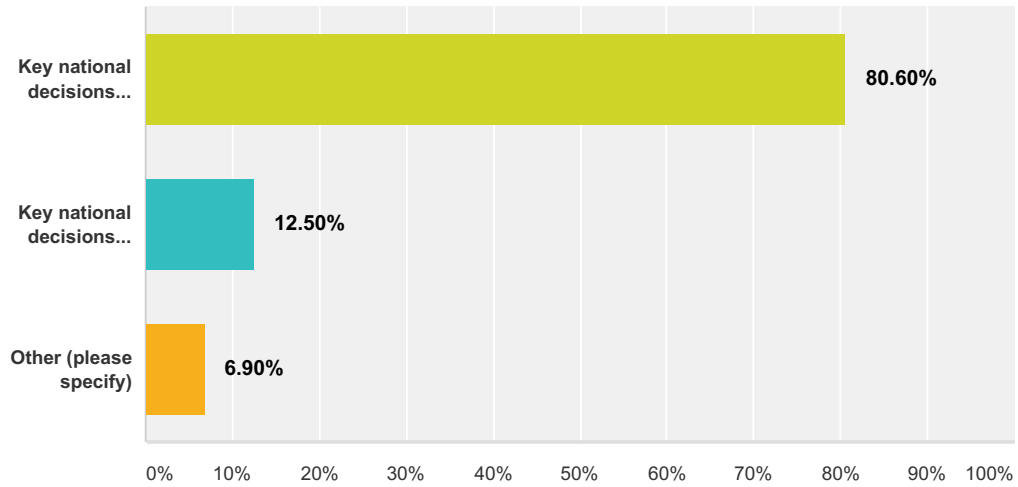

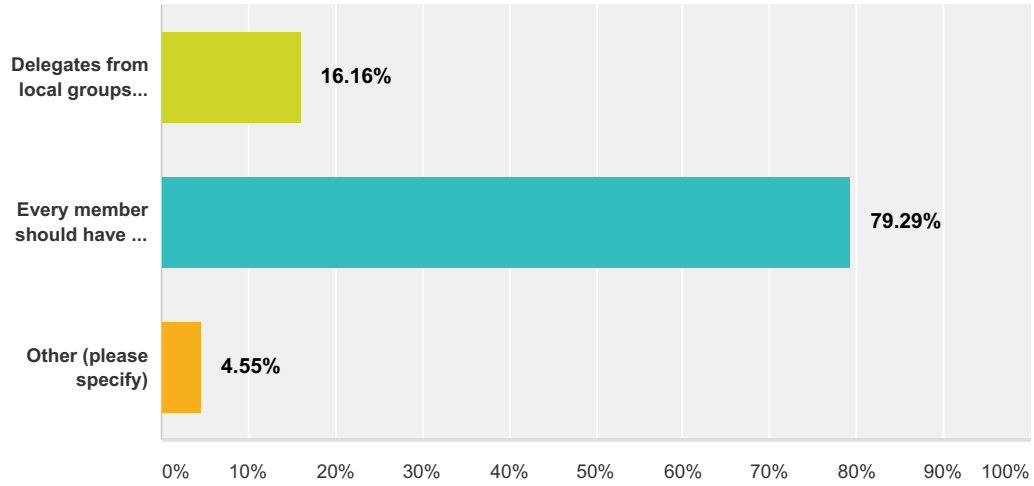
